

# Synthesis Essay Instructions

**Directions** Follow the guidelines below as you write your paper on this subject.

**Background** Recently, we have examined thematic relationships in *Julius Caesar* and *Wall Street: Money Never Sleeps*. The purpose of this synthesis essay is to create a unique claim that examines how characters from each story teach the audience about the relationship between two of the themes.

**Requirements** This paper must do or include the following:

- 2+ Pages (double-spaced, typed with 12-point times new roman font and standard margins)
- In MLA Format: cite sources, have a header, your name/ teacher's name/ class/ date (listed at the top of your page), works cited page
- Centered around a claim about how the characters develop the relationship between your two themes.
- Refer to or include **four quotations** from **two sources**: *Julius Caesar* and *Wall Street: Money Never Sleeps*. Two quotes/paraphrases per body paragraph.
- Upload your paper to turnitin.com and submit a hard copy on the assigned date
